Organization Overview:

Prevention Point Philadelphia (PPP) is a multi-service public health organization dedicated to promoting health, empowerment, and safety for communities affected by drug use and poverty. PPP meets people where they are, providing information and access to resources with dignity and respect. Using a prevention-based approach, PPP offers low-threshold, culturally sensitive, non-judgmental services to address the health and social service needs of people impacted by substance use.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assists in the setup and breakdown of Love Lot & Drop-In services.
- Maintains the standards of accurate and complete recording and reporting of program activities.
- Maintains participant confidentiality as required by local, state, and federal law
- Adheres to Prevention Point's approach of meeting people where they are and withholding judgment about choices they make.
- Connects clients to appropriate PPP services
- Provides information, education and referral regarding testing and preventative services to clients as required.
- Conducts venue-based outreach to potential clients and to community organizations serving high-risk populations.
- Maintains the standards of accurate and complete recording and reporting of program activities.
- Assist with crisis de-escalation and coordinate response to mental health crises.
